TASTING NOTES

A classic blend of Grenache, Syrah, Cinsault and Vermentino, the Maison Williams Chase Rosé is a beautiful pale shade of pink. Bone dry, the wine boasts delicate aromas of peaches and raspberries, followed by a refreshing note of grapefruit on a backdrop of savoury Provençal herbs. A moreish creamy texture sits in harmony with a steely minerality working towards a long, mouth-watering, lingering finish. The wine is a singing tribute to Provence and the long sunny days from this very special part of the world.

WINEMAKING

Fruit is harvested during the early hours of the morning, ensuring optimum acidity in the grapes before destemming and pressing begins. Pure free-run juice from each cuvée ensures minimal skin contact, imparting the delicate hue of pink that looks so enticing in a glass. Ageing on the lees for the Grenache cuvée instils a richness to the blend and a small portion benefits from judicious use of oak, enhancing the complexity and depth. The cuvées are blended and allowed to harmonise before being bottled at the Château and sealed with our signature vinolock glass closure.
